Time for Some Science!


How do clouds form?



The sun heats up water, turning it into gas that rises to the sky

This is called evaporation!


How do clouds form?



Up in the sky where it's cooler, the gas turns back into liquid water.


This is called condensation!

How do clouds form?



The water droplets group together and form clouds.

Why does it rain?



When the cloud becomes too heavy, the water drops fall down as rain!

This is called precipitation!

Today you will need....





- Water
- 2 Plastic Cups
- Shaving Cream
- A Dropper
- Blue Food Coloring



STEP 1:

Add a few drops of food coloring to ONE water cup.



STEP 2:

Add shaving cream to the CLEAR water Cup.



STEP 3:

Take the dropper & pick up some blue rainwater.



STEP 4:

Slowly add drops of blue water to the top of the shaving cream.



STEP 5:

Watch as the blue water rains from the shaving cream cloud!

Bonus Questions!

Why do you think the shaving cream cloud floats on top of the water?

Why don't the blue drops stay on top of the cloud? Why do they sink through to the clear water?

Bonus Answers!

Different objects have more or less space between their particles. This is called density!

Shaving cream is <u>less dense</u> than water. Its airiness helps it float!

The blue drops of water are <u>more dense</u> than the shaving cream, so they sink.
